



2008 STN Executive Council Elections

BACKGROUND

The Student Television Network is looking for strong leaders who will commit to this organization's continued growth and progress, as it serves scholastic broadcasting in a spirit of cooperation and unity. Affiliate teachers who would be willing to serve STN in this capacity provide STN's inspiration and direction through their two-year terms on the STN Executive Council. The continuity of STN and its support to schools, teachers, and students interested in broadcasting, video production, and journalism can only be insured if STN teachers are willing to serve in leadership roles.

The STN Executive Council is charged with ensuring that the objectives of Student Television Network are met, and to carry out duties outlined by STN's bylaws. The STN Executive Council meets in person or via conference call on a quarterly basis to address the needs of STN's affiliates. The Executive Council often continues this communication with each other through a dedicated e-mail list.

There will be seven (out of sixteen) Executive Council (EC) members whose terms have expired in the 2008 election cycle, and eight who will continue one more year before they leave or are re-elected in 2009.

All "Intent to Run" e-mails must be sent on or before May 28th, 2008. You will receive email notification that your "Intent to Run" e-mail has been received. If you are determined to be an STN Affiliate teacher in good standing you will be listed as a candidate for the STN Executive Council.

Every STN member affiliate will be contacted via e-mail on Monday, June 2nd, with a link to the list of candidates. Voting (via a process to be e-mailed from the 2008 STN Election Committee) will take place during that week and the election will conclude Friday, June 13th, at midnight.

STN affiliates will be notified of the results the following week. Every affiliate who votes will receive confirmation that their vote has been received.

Your current STN Executive Council representative encourages you to be a part of the promising future of our organization. STN looks forward to your interest and your service.
