STUDENT TELEVISION NETWORK PROMOTES NEW STN ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

CARLSBAD, CA – Student Television Network, an international association of high school and middle school broadcasting, film and media programs, has announced the formation of the STN Alumni Association. The Alumni Association will unite past students who have taken part in STN events.

Since 1999, STN has provided support, curriculum and community to teachers and students in broadcast journalism, film and media programs. The Alumni Association will provide a forum for students to share experiences, professional events and a continued sense of community. STN hopes to create a website for the Association where job openings can be shared, social and networking events can be promoted and alumni can be introduced to the many ways they can give back to STN as judges, volunteers and donors.

“We are creating the Alumni Association as an extension of the current STN high school and middle school community,” said Nancy Held Loucas, CEO. “The Association will further extend STN’s reach into colleges and professional careers realized as a result of the impact of this organization.”

STN selected Grant Bochantin as the Chairman of the Alumni Association Committee. Grant has been involved with STN since 2007 when he was a student at Marquette High School in Chesterfield, MO. Since high school, Grant has been working with STN on training videos, convention production and outreach to the professional community.

“I hope to be a catalyst for anyone who has participated in STN to continue their support while discovering the vast community of alumni,” said Grant Bochantin. “We all have a common cause of support for STN and we want to find ways to nurture that.”

Currently, Student Television Network works with over 400 schools all year long to support teachers and their students in broadcast journalism, film and multimedia. Each year, STN holds an annual convention attended by 12-18 year old students, their teachers and chaperones. Attendees take part in four days of education, interaction with peers and professionals, and competition.
