### **STUDENT TELEVISION NETWORK ANNOUNCES COLLABORATIVE DOCUMENTARY** *Eight Schools to Participate in Film on Disabilities*

CARLSBAD, CA – Student Television Network, an international association of high school and middle school broadcasting, film and media programs, has announced the details of this year’s Collaborative Documentary entitled, *No Limits: A New View of Disability*.

Seven STN Member schools were selected by the documentary team to represent varying viewpoints on the topic. All of the schools will produce individual segments of the film that will be edited into a final presentation. The film will premiere at STN’s 14<sup>th</sup> annual convention in Anaheim, CA. The convention draws high school students and teachers from around the world for four days of education, interaction with professionals and competition. At the film’s premiere, student producers will be on hand to take questions and explain the process.

“The goal of the film is to teach students the collaborative process while exploring interesting subjects with various perspectives,” said Jacki Romey, Producer and President of the STN Board of Directors. “Today’s creative process involves remote collaboration and the students will gain first-hand knowledge of that procedure.”
