### CONTEST OBJECTIVE & RULES

- Produce a fictional Short Film based on a program title and main character.
- Production: 8 hours
- High school and middle school: 1 team of unlimited participants.
- Entries should not exceed 8 minutes, or face penalty from the judges.
- Teams may go anywhere in the Seattle area to produce an entry, there are no boundaries.
- 100% of all video footage contained in an entry must be shot during the contest period.
- Only titles and effects created during the contest period may be used in an entry.
- Only royalty free or original music may be used in an entry.
- Entries should refrain from topics considered inappropriate for young viewers. Entries that use gratuitous sex, drugs, or violence may be penalized.
- Teacher may participate in creating an entry

### JUDGING & EVALUATION

The judges will be looking for short films that make a strong connection to the title. Entries should get the viewer's attention and keep it. Beginning, middle, end, and overall pacing are very important.

Judges will focus on the following criteria:

- ★ Camera/Direction
- ★ Lighting
- ★ Audio/Sound/Music
- ★ Editing
- ★ Storytelling/Content
- ★ Continuity
- ★ Creativity
- ★ Acting/Talent
- ★ Closeness to Topic
- ★ Followed Directions

### CONTEST PROCEDURES

- Review the topic on social media
- Pick up the contest materials from the Assignment Desk.
- Plan, record and edit production.

### EXTRA ATTENTION

**NOTE:** Entries may be edited anywhere EXCEPT your home school facilities (Seattle area schools). Editing space and table rentals are available from STN for an additional charge.

### SUBMITTING YOUR ENTRY

- Copy your entry to the flashdrive.
- Name your entry file using your contest ID # (Found on the contest pouch).
- Put the flashdrive into the pouch and turn it into the Contest Booth before deadline.
- No entries will be accepted past deadline.
