CONTEST OBJECTIVE & RULES

- Edit a sports montage using the clips provided.
- Teams will use the clips provided to create an "Action Sports Edit" for a given athlete/sport.
- Production: 3 hours of editing (review included)
- High School: One team of up to 2 students
- Segments should not exceed 60 seconds.
- Only approved royalty-free music is allowed.
- Only effects and graphics created during the contest period may be used.
- You must report to the edit room at the assigned time, with your editing equipment.
- You may not set up your equipment in the edit room before the assigned edit time.
- Please refer to the Edit Room Rules & Procedures document on the STN Website.
- You may not receive assistance on your entry from an outside party. No teacher support.

JUDGING & EVALUATION

The judges are looking for well-crafted entries that communicate the action in a memorable way. Entries should get the viewer's attention and keep it. The beginning, middle and end, as well as the overall pacing are important. Creativity and impact of the piece will be the major criteria in the evaluation process.

Judges will focus on the following criteria:

- ★ Editing
- ★ Graphics/Effects
- ★ Creativity
- ★ Complexity
- ★ Audio/Sound/Music
- ★ Followed Directions

CONTEST PROCEDURES

- Report to the Assignment Desk to receive your contest materials and instructions.
- Report to the edit room wearing a wristband and with your Edit Ticket.
- Review the provided action sports clips.
- Edit in a room supervised by STN.

EXTRA ATTENTION

NOTE: To enter this editing contest, you must be able to use the video clips provided on the contest flashdrive. The clips will be .mp4 files compressed using H.264 720p. Please download the "TEST FILE" on the convention page to see if your editing system is compatible.

SUBMITTING YOUR ENTRY

- Copy your entry to the flashdrive provided.
- Name your entry file using your contest ID # (Found on the contest pouch).
- Place the flashdrive back into the contest pouch and return it to the Contest Booth before the posted deadline.
- No entries will be accepted past the deadline.
