CONTEST OBJECTIVE & RULES

- Produce a News Magazine program based on a topic (ala 60 Minutes) with segments all focused on the prompt. Each segment stands alone but fits within the overall topic. Multiple reporters anchor each piece.
- Production: 8 hours
- High school and middle school: 1 team of unlimited participants.
- Entries should not exceed 8 minutes.
- Teams may go anywhere in the Washington DC area to produce an entry, there are no boundaries.
- 100% of all video footage contained in an entry must be shot during contest period.
- Lower-thirds titles and other effects created during the contest period may be used.
- Only royalty free or original music may be used in an entry.
- Schools may use their previously produced opens and graphics that are part of their regularly produced program.
- Adviser may participate in creating an entry.

JUDGING & EVALUATION

The judges will be looking for shows that make a strong connection to the topic. Entries should get the viewer's attention and keep it. Beginning, middle, end, and overall pacing in the segments are very important.

Evaluations will focus on the following criteria:

- ★ Camera/Direction
- ★ Lighting
- ★ Audio/Sound
- ★ Camera Presence/Talent
- ★ Storytelling
- ★ Integrity/Courage
- ★ Show Structure/Writing
- ★ Creativity
- ★ Closeness to Topic
- ★ Followed Directions

CONTEST PROCEDURES

- Review the topic on social media
- Pick up the contest materials from the Assignment Desk.
- Plan, record and edit production.

EXTRA ATTENTION

NOTE: Entries may be edited anywhere EXCEPT your home school facilities (DC area schools). Editing space and table rentals are available from STN for an additional charge

SUBMITTING YOUR ENTRY

- Copy your entry to the flashdrive.
- Name your entry file using your contest ID # (Found on the contest pouch).
- Put the flashdrive into the pouch and turn it into the Contest Booth before deadline.
- No entries will be accepted past deadline.
