STN will provide a script for a news story scheduled to air on the evening newscast. Based on that story, submit three (3) promotional multimedia elements you think are appropriate for posting on Social Media Requirements Include: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> :10 second reporter standup promoting the upcoming story a single photo you take to entice viewers to click a persuasive headline Stick to the story provided. Do not invent any random information. Stay within the topic There is no editing for this contest. Graphics, titles, and in-camera effects are not allowed. You may not receive assistance on your entry from an outside party. No teacher support 	<p>JUDGING & EVALUATION</p> <p>Judges will look for a promotional stand-up that is credible with important information presented in an interesting and appropriate manner. Promos should be appropriate for the subject matter. Reporters should speak clearly, watch posture, and avoid clothing that is distracting/inappropriate. Photos should be representative of the story and interesting. Headline copy should be catchy.</p> <p>Judges will focus on the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Camera Presence ★ Reporter Look/Style ★ Reporter Writing ★ Enunciation/Inflection ★ Microphone Technique ★ Camera Operation ★ Photo Image Quality & Composition ★ Headline Quality ★ Closeness to Topic ★ Followed Directions
