



STN CONVENTION INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Student Television Network

STN is a nonprofit international association of more than 400 high school and middle school broadcast journalism, film and media programs. The 17th Annual STN Convention will take place March 12-15, 2020 in Washington DC. The convention brings together students and teachers for four days of education, interaction and competition. The goal of the convention is to network students and teachers with professionals who can share real life experience and advice. More than 3,000 attendees are expected at STN 2020.

Internship Opportunity

STN Alumni are eligible to apply for the Convention Internship program. Interns will learn what it takes to run a successful live event and gain real life experience as a volunteer working behind-the-scenes at the world's premier high school/middle school television and film convention.

Interns are selected by how well suited they are at meeting the internship criteria.

Minimum criteria:

- A member of STN's Alumni Association [Not a member? Join now](#)
- Previously attended one or more STN conventions
- Available March 10th-16th 2020 to work and travel
- Holds a valid government issued ID permitting you to travel to and from Washington DC, USA on the aforementioned dates
- Shares a passion for STN's mission to support student broadcasting and film programs

Additional criteria:

- Prior experience working at events strongly preferred
- Recommendations from teachers/faculty of STN member schools, STN Employees, STN Convention Interns, and other STN-affiliated individuals
- History of involvement with STN (participated in Contests, won awards, inducted into Honor Society)

Agreement

First year interns - If you are selected as a first year intern, you are responsible for hotel and travel expenses. Returning interns – Based on our staffing needs and individual performance reviews, some interns will be selected to return for a fully paid internship, including airfare, transportation, shared accommodation, and meals on-site during the STN 2020 convention.

If, after being accepted, you are unable to attend and work at the STN 2020 convention due to any circumstances, you agree to reimburse STN for costs incurred. Any costs associated with changes to flights or hotel after they have been booked are your responsibility.

Responsibilities

Volunteers' job roles at the event may include (not limited to):

- Assist in loading and unloading, setting up and tearing down, packing and unpacking
- Monitor conduct of contest participants and convention attendees
- Monitor crowd safety
- Liaise with vendors, hotel staff, and others
- Act as an ambassador for STN
- Work cooperatively as a team with STN Staff and Interns
- Additional responsibilities as needed
