An Historic American Hotel

Built in 1965, the Washington Hilton boasts a magnificent garden setting that overlooks the capital city's impressive skyline. Located on fashionable upper **Connecticut Avenue**, a quarter-mile from the **Dupont Circle Metro** station, this historic hotel is minutes from monuments, museums, **Georgetown**, **Adams-Morgan**, **Embassy Row**, the **Washington business district**, and all local points of interest.



55 Years of Newsworthy History

Numerous large events have been regularly hosted at the Washington Hilton, including the annual dinners of the **White House Correspondents Association** and the **Radio and Television Correspondents Association**, as well as the **National Prayer Breakfast**. During the 1960s and 1970s, the hotel hosted a number of big musical acts for concerts in their large ballroom, including **The Doors** and **Jimi Hendrix**. The hotel was the site of the assassination attempt on **President Ronald Reagan** by John Hinckley, Jr. on March 30, 1981.
