

LIFE SAFETY & EVACUATION PROCEDURES FOR GUESTS

WASHINGTON HILTON

IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY, THE SECURITY DEPARTMENT WILL COMMUNICATE WITH GUESTS

- Hotel internal emergency phone: **#60**
- Hotel internal non-emergency phone: **#65**

EVACUATION / FIRE

- The guest fire evacuation notice is displayed in all guest rooms.
- There are 4 emergency exit stairwells located on the guest floors.
- The sound of the fire alarm is **Siren & Announcement**.
- Pull Station/Break glass call points are clearly identified throughout the hotel and are operated by **Pulling the Lever**
- **The main fire Assembly Point is located outside the Lobby & Terrace Level entrances. Everyone is asked to exit via the nearest exit.**
- In case a fire alarm is activated while you are in a meeting room or Ballroom, evacuate via the nearest exit.
- Once the fire department gives the **“All Clear,”** all guests will be asked to return back into the building by hotel staff.
- A separate procedure for assisting identified disabled guests in the event of emergency evacuation is in place.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- In case of a medical emergency, call **# 60** from any hotel house phone.
- If you happen to dial 911 on your own, please call #60 as well to inform the hotel about the emergency.
